## Edvance School Year Calendar 2023-2024

Provisions made by the Ontario Ministry of Education under Regulations 298 and 304 regarding school days and the school year calendar apply to public schools only. Therefore, the calendar issued by the MOE is optional advice for independent schools.

## INSTRUCTIONAL TIME

## Elementary Schools

The Ministry of Education expectation for 2023-2024 is that there will be a minimum of 194 school days which will include a local count of instructional and PD days. http://www.edu.gov.on.ca/eng/general/list/calendar/holidaye.html

The local school calendar should specify the appropriate number of instructional and professional development days that complies with the school's policy requirements.

## Secondary Schools

The calendar should specify the appropriate number of instructional days to meet the (OSSD) diploma requirements for credits (min. 110 hours, see Ontario Schools, Kindergarten to Grade 12: Policy and Program Requirements, 2016, p. 70) and may designate up to 10 of the instructional days as examination days.

## School days

School days are all days available for instruction and professional activities. There are 194 school days available between September 1 and June 30 (inclusive).

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School Days = Instructional Days + Professional Development Days
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## Holidays

Dates listed are those the Ministry of Education has mandated for the public systems (10 days at Christmas and 5 days for March break). Edvance affiliate schools should plan holidays to fit local circumstances. Changing the holidays may change the number of instructional days.

## Start of School

Note that the Education Act specifies that "the school year shall commence on or after the 1st day of September and end on or before the 30th day of June. (R.R.O. 1990, Reg. 304, s.2(1).

As an independent school, an Edvance affiliate school is not bound by this limitation and can begin school before September 1. Edvance affiliate schools are encouraged to fit their school year schedule to fit local circumstances.
